Gracia Burnham-Speaker Williamsburg, VA Sept. 7, 2012

Our Friday evening speaker will be **Gracia Burnham**, former missionary with New Tribes Mission in the Philippines and widow of Martin Burnham. For 17 years she and Martin served as missionaries in the Philippines where Martin was a jungle pilot. On May 27, 2001, while celebrating their 18th wedding anniversary at a resort off Palawan Island, the Burnham's were kidnapped by the Abu Sayyaf, a Muslim militant group. Held captive for 376 days, on June 7, 2002 their captivity ended in a violent rescue that left Martin dead and Gracia wounded. Their story of faith in the midst of terror and tragedy is known to millions. Since that time Gracia had authored the New York Times bestselling book "In the Presence of My Enemies" and her latest book is "To Fly Again." She is the founder of The Martin and Gracia Burnham Foundation and mother to Jeffrey, Melinda and Zachary. You won't want to miss Gracia's story of their struggle to live a life of faith amidst terror.

Revel, former US Marine Corps officer, pastor and actor who starred as Lieutenant Michael Simmons in the 2008 movie "Fireproof" and as police officer Nathan Hayes the 2011 movie "Courageous."
